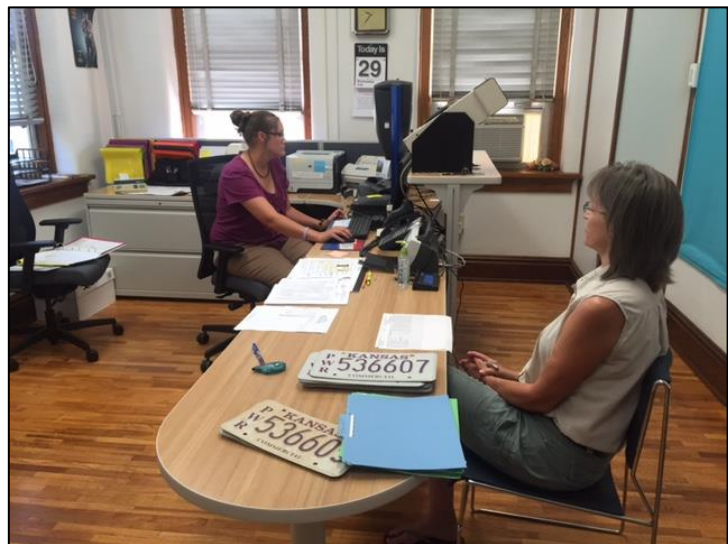

Commercial tag service up and running in Kingman County

Commercial vehicle tag services are up and running in the Kingman County Treasurer's Office.

Regina Adelhardt, office manager for Klaver Construction Company in Kingman, was in the office Tuesday to pick up tags for two new commercial vehicles for the company.

She called the local availability of the services "great," noting that previously the company had to travel to Greensburg for commercial tags.

"It's really nice," she said as Jamie Smith, commercial tag specialist for the Treasurer's Office, processed her vehicles.

Smith and other staff members recently took training on commercial vehicle processing. New equipment and furniture were purchased and placed in the driver's license office on the northeast corner of the second floor of the Kingman County Courthouse to accommodate commercial tag services. Driver's license services also will continue in the office.

Commercial vehicle owners in Kingman County wanting to access the tag services should call the Treasurer's Office to make an appointment (620-532-3461). The service is open only to Kingman County commercial vehicles.
