Annual flu vaccine now available

The Kingman County Health Department now is offering the annual flu vaccine to the public.

Flu vaccines available this year from the Health Department are the Quadrivalent Flu Vaccine, which helps prevent the four flu strains most likely to cause the most problems this flu season; the High-Dose Flu Vaccine, which provides the best flu protection for those aged 65 years and older, and the Nasal Flu Vaccine, available for children ages 2-18 years without underlying health concerns.

Almost everyone over 6 months of age is encouraged to get vaccinated from the flu, especially those who already deal with chronic health problems, pregnant women, and anyone who comes in close contact with people at high risk of becoming seriously ill from the flu.
