Vacant house destroyed by fire in Spivey

A vacant house in Spivey was destroyed by fire on Tuesday, April 19.

The Kingman County 911 Center received a call of a house on fire at 201 N. Vail in Spivey at 10:29 p.m. April 19. The Spivey Fire Department and the Kingman County Sheriff's Office responded to the scene and found a single story house engulfed in flames. The house was not being lived in and no one was inside at the time of the fire.

The Spivey Fire Department was on the scene for more than three hours. The house was a total loss.

The cause of the fire is under investigation. The Kansas Fire Marshal's Office has been called in to assist in the investigation.

Kingman Emergency Medical Services and Kingman County Emergency Management also responded to support firefighters.
