### **\$15 flu vaccine available Jan. 6-8**

The Kingman County Health Department urges anyone who has not yet gotten the annual flu vaccine to “Beat the Flu!” by taking advantage of \$15 vaccinations Jan. 6-8.

The \$15 flu vaccine will be available from the Health Department on those dates as follows:

- Tuesday, Jan. 6 at the Kingman County Health Department, 125 N. Spruce in Kingman;
- Wednesday, Jan. 7 at the Cunningham and Nashville Outreach Clinics;
- Thursday, Jan. 8 at the Murdock and Norwich Outreach Clinics.

Since vaccine supply is limited, Flu Mist, Quadrivalent Flu Vaccine, and the High-Dose Flu Vaccine (for people age 65 and older) will all be available on a first-come/first-serve basis.

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) encourages just about anyone age 6 months and older to be vaccinated for the flu, as this year’s flu season is projected to be more severe than in previous years.

Even though some of the actual flu viruses making people sick haven’t been a perfect match to the flu viruses prevented by this year’s flu vaccine, if you get the flu – it should be less severe than if you didn’t get vaccinated.
