Flu shots available from Health Department on Monday, Sept. 18

The Kingman County Health Department will have flu shots available starting Monday, Sept. 18. Just about anyone ages 6 months and older should consider getting vaccinated. The Health Department will have the High-Dose Flu Vaccine, recommended for people 65 years of age and older, as well as Quadrivalent Flu Vaccine, which is recommended for everyone else.

Influenza is a dangerous illness with fever, body aches, respiratory congestion and shortness of breath. It can lead not only to lost days at work and school, but the flu can worsen chronic health problems, send people to the hospital, and result in death.
