Prescription drug discount card now available

Kingman County residents now can access a free prescription drug discount service being made available by the county.



The discount cards are free and available at the following locations: Kingman County Health Department; Kingman County Courthouse; Kingman Community Hospital; Kingman Drug; cities of Cunningham, Nashville, Norwich, Penalosa, Spivey and Zenda; Donley Memorial Clinic; Kingman Eye Care; Kingman Senior Center; Kingman Chiropractic Center, Veach Chiropractic, and Kingman Medical Arts Center.

This program provides residents discounts on the cost of prescriptions at more than 68,000 retail pharmacies nationwide, including Kingman Drug in Kingman.

Simply pick up a free card and begin using it right away to save on prescriptions not covered by an insurance plan. The cards are not insurance but they save an average of 24 percent off the retail price of prescription medicines. Savings may vary by drug and by pharmacy. Simply show your card to the pharmacist with your prescription.

“As a member of the Live Healthy program, Kingman County is helping our residents save with discounts on everyday prescription costs,” said John Steffen, county commission chairman.
